Abstract Submission Guidelines

Instructions for submitting an abstract for the plenary and poster sessions:

- a. Include the following information when submitting the abstract:
 - Author's name
 - Names of co-authors
 - Designation/title
 - Employing organisation
 - Country of work
 - Contact information
 - Title of abstract
 - Preference for poster or plenary presentation
- b. Allocations of all abstracts for plenary and poster sessions are determined by the abstract review committee

Abstract formatting and content:

- a. All entries must have a presubmission abstract no greater than 300 words
 - Abstracts exceeding this limit will be excluded

- b. Research-based abstracts should include the following:
 - Introduction: state the objective / background of the study
 - Design: describe the material and methods
 - Results: summarise the results, presenting sufficient details to support the conclusions reached
 - Conclusions
- c. Non-research-based abstracts should include the following:
 - Background / problem
 - Project description
 - Project goals
 - Evaluation / results
 - Implications for nursing

General rules:

- a. Abstracts should be checked carefully for accuracy prior to submission, as they are not edited by the organisers and author corrections will not be accepted after the final submission deadline
- b.Only registered nursing delegates may present abstracts

- c. If your abstract is accepted and you do not register for the conference within the appropriate timeframe, your abstract will be withdrawn
- d. The submitting author MUST be the presenting author
- e. Authors may submit more than one abstract
- f. Abstract presentation must be done in the English language
